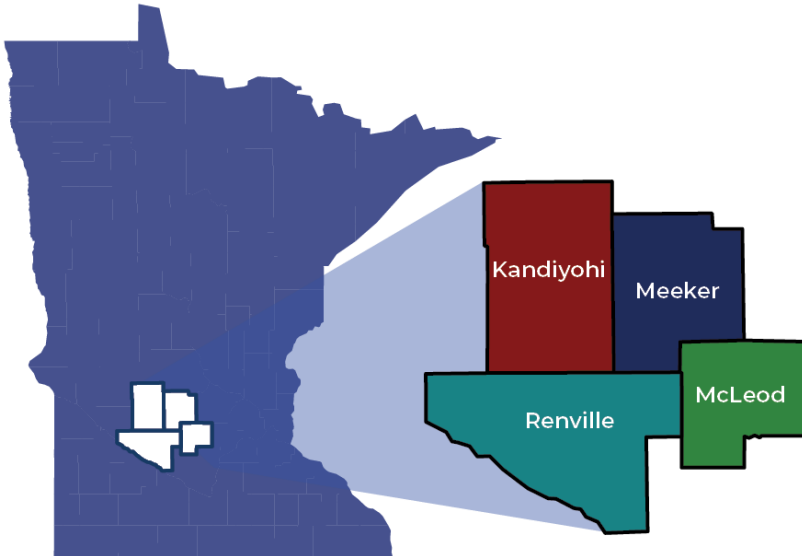


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Rideshare in Kandiyohi County

- Sunday services or Bible studies

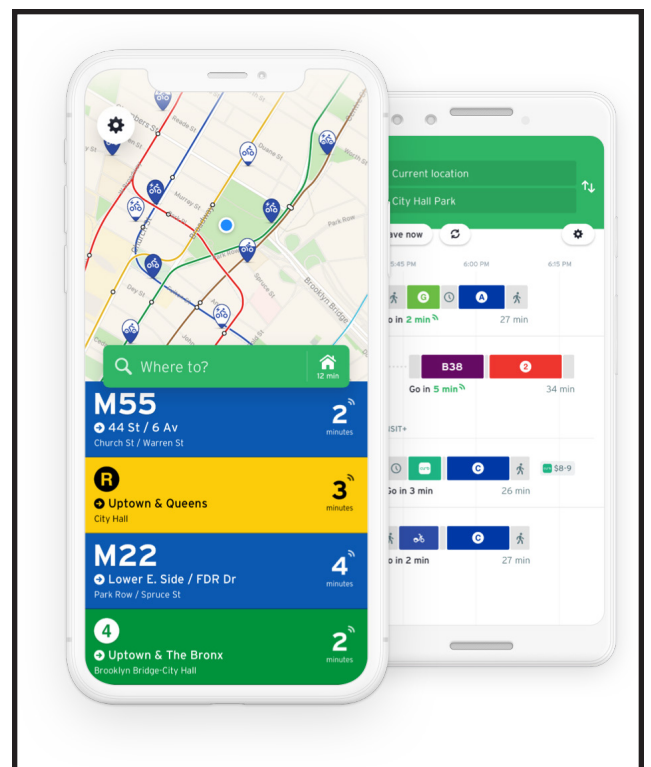


Just download a rideshare app like Uber or Lyft on your smartphone and request a ride when you need one. You'll see the price before you book, and a friendly local driver will pick you up. In-town rides usually range from \$8-\$12

TRANSIT Mobile Device Application

Transit is a mobile app providing real-time public transit data. The app functions in over 175 metropolitan areas around the world. Transit was designed for aggregating and mapping real-time public transit data, crowdsourcing user data to determine the true location of buses and trains. Transit was first released in 2012 for iPhone and soon after launched the Android-compatible version. It offers users schedules and alerts for multiple modes of transportation where available, including bus and rail.

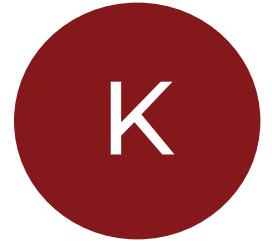
