How: Physical education classroom curriculum When: Annually, during physical education classes



EARN A BIKE

What: A program that provides donated/abandoned bikes and helmets to students in need.

Who: ACGC SD, Atwater PD, Meeker Sherriff's Office How: Acquire bikes through stakeholder donation

When: Annually



BIKE FLEETS

What: A great opportunity to learn about bike safety and bike functionality.

Who: ACGC School District and County SHIP

How: County SHIP bike fleet trailer



WALKING SCHOOL BUS

What: An option for groups of children to walk to school under the supervision of an adult.

Who: ACGC School District Staff or volunteers

How: Acquire volunteers and set designated routes When: Annually, as desired



WALKING FIELD TRIPS

What: Learn safe travel practices while getting out of the classroom to walk to any local destination.

Who: ACGC School District Teachers **How:** Planned days with organized routes When: Annually or biannually



BIKE RODEO

What: An event that presents driving courses designed to simulate actual road situations encountered by bikers. Who: ACGC School District, Cities of Atwater and GC

How: Gather materials and volunteers When: Annually, during community events

INFRASTRUCTURE RECOMMENDATIONS

These maps were used in the process of making infrastructure recommendations for the ACGC School District.


The first map (left) displays the infrastructure recommendations for the ACGC Jr/Sr School. Several different areas were identified as potential sites for added walking paths/trails. A location for an additional drop off zone was also identified. Crossing infrastructure improvements are needed.

The second map (right) shows an aerial image of the ACGC Elementary School and surrounding blocks. Intersections in need of crossing infrastructure improvements and stop signs were identified around the school. The need for curb cut improvements at a number of intersections near to the school was also identified.
